

**NOTE** In addition to the above:

1. The Union Flag may be flown daily to boost morale during challenging times (e.g. pestilence and war)
2. The Flag of St Peter will be flown:
  - a. On the day of a St Peter's Trust Council Meeting or AGM
  - b. At half mast on the death of a St Peter's Trust Council Member, and until the hour of the funeral.
3. The Wiltshire County Flag may be flown for certain events in the Town (e.g. Marlborough in Bloom) or at St Peter's (e.g. Wiltshire Artists' Exhibition)

Occasionally a designated flag may not be flown in high winds.
